Before my husband and I moved to central Ohio in 1986 we had spent 24 years residing with our children in the small community of Canaan, New York where we were active members of the local community church.

Plans for the new building have recently been approved and will be designed in response to the needs of this changing community. The completed building will provide a gathering place for worship, outreach, mission, Bible study, prayer and meditation as well as being available for community events.

Canaan, New York may not be the land of milk and honey, but it has proven to be an amazing place for God-loving people who felt God's presence and responded to His reality.
