New Hearing Assistance System. Just a reminder that a new system known as "The Loop" is now installed in our sanctuary. If you wear hearing aids, you will need to find out if they have the wireless receiver called a T-coil or Telecoil. The T-coil program is accessed by pushing a button on the hearing aid and needs to be activated by your audiologist. Talk to your audiologist to find out if your aids have both a T (picks up no background noise) and an MT program (both microphone & T-coil program). The Loop is made possible by Julie Lothes and her family, in loving memory of her father, Bob Maddox.
