Update on Yearly Mission Project - Watoto Read. Our yearly mission project to build classrooms for the education efforts among refugee children in Chad, Africa has been wonderfully successful. Our initial goal for the year was \$10,000, enough to build 1 classroom. We quickly met that total and moved our goal to \$20,000. We are pleased to announce that we have surpassed the new goal and our project total stands at just over \$20,323. Thank you to all who have contributed, and we know God will bless the work being done in Chad on behalf of some of the world's most challenged people.
