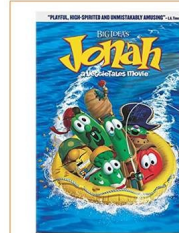

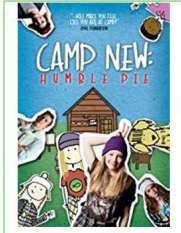

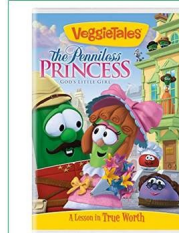

Currently the children attend school outdoors in harsh conditions.

Refugees are persons who are forced to leave their country in order to escape war, persecution, or natural disaster.

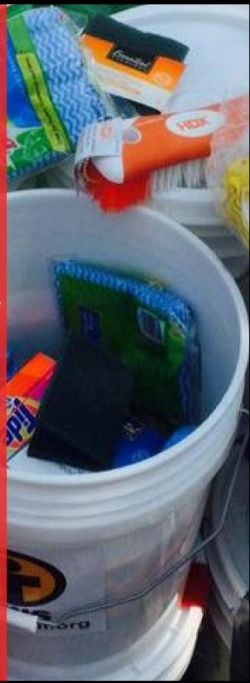

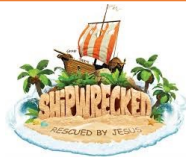
