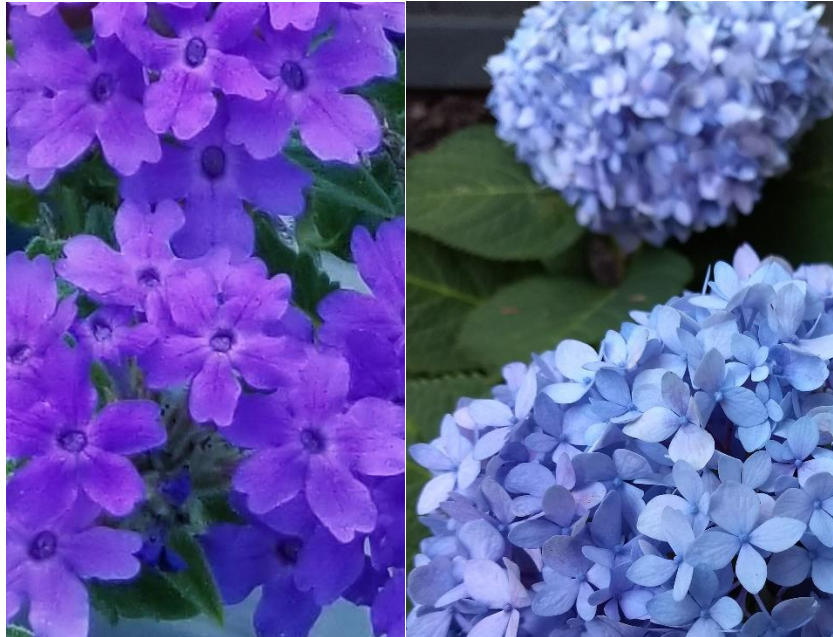


Moments of Beauty Week 2 - Beauty in Cultivated Gardens
